





Why All the Bridges in Sturgeon Bay? HINT: Canal!

he Sturgeon Bay Ship Canal was dug by a private group headed by then-president of Chicago and North Western Railway, William B. Ogden, between July 8, 1872 and the late fall of 1881. Although smaller craft began using the canal in 1880, it was not open for large-scale watercraft until 1890.

The cost of completing the 1.3-mile cut in 1881 was \$291,462.

In 1893, the Ogden private investors group sold all interest in the canal to the United States government. Since that time, the canal has been maintained by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.


The seven-mile long canal was created in part by dredging Sturgeon Bay and the balance by digging the last 1.3 miles. This combined waterway allows ships to sail between Lake Michigan and the Bay of Green Bay without traversing the dangerous Porte des Morts (Death's Door) strait.

The digging of the Canal is undoubtedly one of the most important events in the history of the Door Peninsula and the city of Sturgeon Bay. The brainchild of Joseph Harris, Sr., the historic Ship Canal has shaped the economy and personality of the region since its completion in the 1880s. In addition to economic growth, the Canal made an indelible mark on maritime history in that it spawned lighthouses, lifesaving stations and Sturgeon Bay's remarkable shipbuilding heritage.

Sturgeon Bay Bridge:

Built in 1931 and added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2008, the Sturgeon Bay (Michigan Street) Bridge is the only overhead truss, Scherzer-type, double-leaf, rolling-lift Bascule Bridge that remains in Wisconsin. It has experienced little change since it was constructed in 1931, and remains an excellent example of its type. The bridge maintains its segmental girder, which permits its movement, as well as its Warren and Parker through-trusses that were incorporated to help withstand the sweeping winds of Sturgeon Bay. Additionally, the bridge design was provided by the prominent Chicago firm of Keller & Harrington, which was started by Charles Heller and Howard Parsons Harrington. Both Keller and Harrington had gained bascule and rolling-lift expertise while they were employed with the Charles Scherzer Rolling Lift Bridge Company of Chicago. The firm designed several prominent and impressive bridges across the country. The Sturgeon Bay Bridge is a significant representation of their engineering work.



Maple-Oregon Street Bridge:

This 310-foot long double-leaf rolling lift bascule span bridge over the Sturgeon Bay ship canal was built in 2008 at a length of 1,057 feet. With a lift opening of 200 feet, the Maple-Oregon Bridge is one of the longest draws of any lift bridge in Wisconsin. Aesthetic features such as pedestrian overlooks and architectural light fixtures on the superstructure enhance the bridge's visual appeal for travelers by road and across the bay. Separated from the Michigan Street Bridge by just over 700 feet, the large freighters that utilize the Ship Canal do not clear the first bridge before entering the draw of the second bridge, requiring both bridges to be drawn at the same time – quite a sight to see!

Bayview Bridge:

The Bayview Bridge was completed by the state in 1978 and is part of the bypass highway around the edge of the city. At 46 feet above the water, this bascule lift bridge was constructed high enough that most boats can pass underneath, thereby greatly reducing the number of openings and subsequent inconvenience to motorists traveling the busy highway 42/57 corridor. This bridge is the first bridge encountered by Great Lakes freighters as they navigate from Lake Michigan, through the ship canal, and on to their winter fleet berths at Fincantieri/Bay Shipbuilding in downtown Sturgeon Bay. These cargo ships definitely require the bridge to open but auto traffic stopped on the bridge is treated to the site of these giant working ships passing by.



What is a Fish Boil?

When the fish boil is done, it's served up with plenty of melted butter, your favorite beverage and maybe a slab of Door County Cherry Pie.

ocated at the entrance to the Sturgeon Bay Ship Canal, the North Pierhead Light is an iconic red lighthouse that has been guiding ships since 1882. Its distinctive color and classic design make it a picturesque landmark, perfect for photos and a must-see for visitors. The lighthouse is accessible via a short walk along the pier, offering stunning views of Lake Michigan and the surrounding area.

North Pierhead Lighthouse



S ituated on the southern side of the Sturgeon Bay Ship Canal, this lighthouse was established in 1899 to complement the North Pierhead Light. It features a unique white and red design and stands as a testament to the area's rich maritime history. Although not open to the public, the lighthouse can be viewed from various vantage points along the canal, providing a scenic backdrop for those exploring the area.



DID YOU KNOW? The Sturgeon Bay Ship Canal was built to allow ships to travel through the Door Peninsula instead of using the dangerous Death's Door Passage.

B uilt in 1883, Sherwood Point Lighthouse is perched on the western tip of Sturgeon Bay. This lighthouse is unique as it was the last manned lighthouse on the Great Lakes, remaining staffed until 1983. The lighthouse grounds are open to the public during the annual Lighthouse Festival, and the structure itself serves as a popular subject for photographers. Its scenic location offers panoramic views of the bay and a glimpse into the past maritime life.

DID YOU KNOW? The Sherwood Point Lighthouse is the only lighthouse in Door County made of red brick, while other lighthouses in the area use limestone brick. Limestone and red brick differ in composition, durability, and cost.







Spring (March-May): Ideal for catching walleye and northern pike.

Summer (June-August): Best time for smallmouth bass and perch.

Fall (September-November): Great for trout and salmon fishing.
